

1. Admissions Overview

Programmes in English (Autumn intake 2026)

EMU offers several **international degree programmes** taught in English:

- **Veterinary Medicine** (6-year integrated Bachelor + Master)
- **Master's in Landscape Architecture**
- **Master's in Environmental Governance and Adaptation to Climate Change** (application deadlines vary by study level and citizenship) [Eesti Maailikool](#)

How to Apply

Application Platform:

- Apply online via **DreamApply** (opens Feb 1, 2026). [Eesti Maailikool](#)

Required Documents (generally):

- Online application form with personal data
- **Motivation letter**
- **Certified copies** of education documents + **official English translations**
- **Passport copy**
- Proof of **English language proficiency** (see country-specific requirements) [Eesti Maailikool](#)

Application Fee:

- **€100** non-refundable fee required for Master's/Doctoral applications.
- Vet Med programme is *fee-exempt*. [Eesti Maailikool](#)

Decision & Admission Letter:

- After review, successful applicants receive an official offer letter electronically via DreamApply. [Eesti Maailikool](#)

Program-Specific Admissions Rules

- **Bachelor's level:** Secondary education qualification eligible for higher education.
- **Master's level:** Bachelor's degree or equivalent with minimum academic performance requirements (e.g., $\geq 60\%$ CGPA for some programmes).
- **Country-specific credential requirements** apply — check detailed lists in the university's admission pages. [Eesti Maailikool](#)

2. Country-Specific Document Requirements

EMÜ has **detailed rules** for education documents from different countries. These include:

- Required certificates/transcripts
- How documents must be certified
- Where hard copies must be posted (Department of Academic Affairs in Tartu) [Eesti Maaülikool](#)

Example requirements:

- For **India**: Higher Secondary Certificate and marks statement must be certified, and grades under 50 % are generally considered failing.
 - For other countries: separate rules exist – always check the official page for your country. [Eesti Maaülikool](#)

3. Visa & Residence Permit

EU / EEA / Swiss Citizens

- EU/EEA/Swiss citizens do ****not** need a study visa but must register their **right of residence** and address in Estonia within 3 months after arrival.
- They should also get an Estonian **ID card**. [studyinestonia.ee](#)

Non-EU / Third-Country Citizens

Generally required steps:

1. **Long-stay visa (D type):** apply at Estonian embassy/consulate after receiving the admission letter.
2. **Temporary Residence Permit (TRP) for studies:** apply at the Police and Border Guard Board once in Estonia or after visa issuance.
3. **Register place of residence** in the Estonian population register within ~30 days of getting the permit. [studyinestonia.ee](#)

Processing tips:

- Visa processing can take several weeks; start early.
- Sufficient financial proof and health insurance are typically required for TRP. [studyinestonia.ee](#)

Work rights:

- Students with a valid TRP may work in Estonia **without a separate work permit**, as long as work doesn't interfere with studies. [Migration and Home Affairs](#)

4. Arrival & Orientation

□ Orientation Week

- EMÜ organizes an **Orientation Week** at the end of August for new international students to help them adapt, meet peers, and learn about university systems. [Eesti Maaülikool](#)

□ Registration Deadlines

- Non-EU students must complete **arrival registration** with the Department of Academic Affairs by **September 1, 2026**, or risk visa/offer revocation. [Eesti Maaülikool](#)
