

University of Luxembourg – What You Should Prepare for Admission in 2026

Thinking about studying at the University of Luxembourg? Here's your friendly but thorough guide to everything you need to know to prepare your application and meet key deadlines for the 2026 academic year.

When to Apply? Important Deadlines to Remember

The University of Luxembourg opens admissions for the academic year starting in September (Fall intake) every year, with applications typically opening on **February 1st** of the year. For the 2026 intake, be sure to prepare your materials early.

- Deadline for non-EU candidates is usually around **April 29th, 2026**, but this can vary by program.
 - EU/EEA candidates may have later or rolling deadlines for some programs.
- Pro tip: Start early! The university requires you to get your secondary school diploma recognized by the Luxembourg Ministry of Education, which might take **at least 6 weeks**.

Academic Requirements: Do You Qualify?

To be eligible:

- Hold a valid **secondary school diploma or equivalent** with good academic standing; a **minimum GPA of 3.0/4.0** or equivalent is generally required.
- Non-EU students need to have their qualifications approved by Luxembourg authorities.

Language proficiency is key. Many programs are multilingual: English, French, and German are commonly used. For English-taught programs, you typically need:

- **IELTS** scores between **5.5 and 6.5** depending on the course, or
- **TOEFL iBT** scores from **87 to 100**.

For some programs, French or German proficiency can boost your application chances.

What Documents Should You Prepare?

You'll generally need:

- Secondary school diploma (translated and certified as needed)
- Proof of language proficiency (IELTS, TOEFL, DELF, etc.)
- Passport copy
- Motivation statement or essay (if required)
- Curriculum Vitae (for some master's programs)
- Application fee payment confirmation (typically €50 for undergrads and graduates)

Make sure your documents are ready before you start your application to avoid delays.

Study Options & Tuition Fees

The University of Luxembourg offers a broad range of programs, including over 17 Bachelor's degrees and 46 Master's degrees in fields ranging from Finance and Computer Science to Law and Humanities.

Tuition is affordable for a Western European university, generally:

- **€0 to €5,200 per year** for most public programs
- Specialized Master's degrees can be higher
- Scholarships and financial aid options are available to international students.
