

## 1. General Academic Regulations

The main **Regulations for Full-time Study Programmes at NHH**, adopted by the NHH Board, govern study programmes (Bachelor's and Master's). These regulations were last modified on **17 June 2025** and came into force on **1 August 2024**.[NHH](#)

### □ Scope

- Applies to **full-time study programmes** at NHH (Bachelor and Master).[NHH](#)
- Covers grading, programme structure, admission, diplomas and transcripts.[NHH](#)

### □ Key Points

- **Admission documentation** must be submitted in readable format before deadlines.[NHH](#)
  - **Reserve study places** allowed for military service, pregnancy, birth, adoption, etc. up to two years.[NHH](#)
  - **Graduation diplomas** are issued only once; replacements can be requested.[NHH](#)
  - **Transcripts** are normally issued digitally.[NHH](#)

## 2. Admission Guidelines

### □ Bachelor Programmes (BSc)

For the **Bachelor in Business, Economics and Data Science**:

#### □ Eligibility

- Upper secondary degree equivalent to Norwegian “generell studiekompetanse.”[NHH](#)
- **English proficiency and mathematics requirements**.[NHH](#)
- Minimum mathematics level requirements vary by country and diploma type.[NHH](#)

#### □ Application Process

- Some applicants apply through **Samordna Opptak** (centralised admission system in Norway).[NHH](#)
- International applicants not eligible through this system apply locally via the NHH portal.[NHH](#)

#### □ Documentation and Deadlines

- Deadlines and documentation differ by nationality (EU/EEA/Swiss vs non-EU/EEA).[NHH](#)
- Must upload degrees, transcripts, language proof, and any required test results by specified deadlines.[NHH](#)

## ☐ Master Programmes (MSc)

For the **Master in Economics and Business Administration**:

### ☐ Academic Requirements

- A **Bachelor's degree or equivalent** (minimum comparable to a Norwegian bachelor).[NHH](#)
- **90 ECTS credits** in economics and business administration, including:
  - At least **30 ECTS in business administration subjects**.[NHH](#)
  - Up to **45 ECTS in quantitative method subjects** (e.g., statistics).[NHH](#)

### 📄☐ Tests and Language

- **GMAT or GRE** required unless exempt (e.g., Nordic degrees, CEMS or PIM network).[NHH](#)
- **English language proficiency** must be demonstrated unless exempted (e.g., English-taught degree, specific study criteria).[NHH](#)

### ☐ Deadlines

- The MSc application portal typically opens **on 1 November**, with a deadline around **15 February** (midnight CET).[NHH](#)

## ☐ 3. Supplementary Admission Pathways

NHH also has provisions for **admission based on prior learning and relevant work experience**, with specific language, mathematics, and work experience requirements (e.g., 5 years of relevant work).[NHH](#)
