ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Foundation & Diploma Programmes: Completion of high school or equivalent qualifications.
- **Undergraduate Programmes:** A recognised pre-university qualification (A-Level, IB, or equivalent).
- **Postgraduate Programmes:** A relevant bachelor's degree or master's from an accredited institution.
- English Proficiency: IELTS, TOEFL, or equivalent (compulsory).

APPLICATION PROCESS

- 1. **Choose Your Programme** Explore our programmes and select your preferred course of study.
- 2. **Check Entry Requirements** Ensure you meet academic and English language requirements and prepare for application.
- Submit Your Application Apply online and attach necessary documents, including your passport copy, academic transcripts and other relevant documents.
- Receive Offer Letter If accepted, you will receive a conditional or unconditional offer.
- 5. **Visa Application & Approval** Submit your student visa application with assistance from our International Student Office(ISO).
- 6. **Travel & Arrival** Upon successful visa approval, ISO will assist in advising your travelling period and airport clearance.

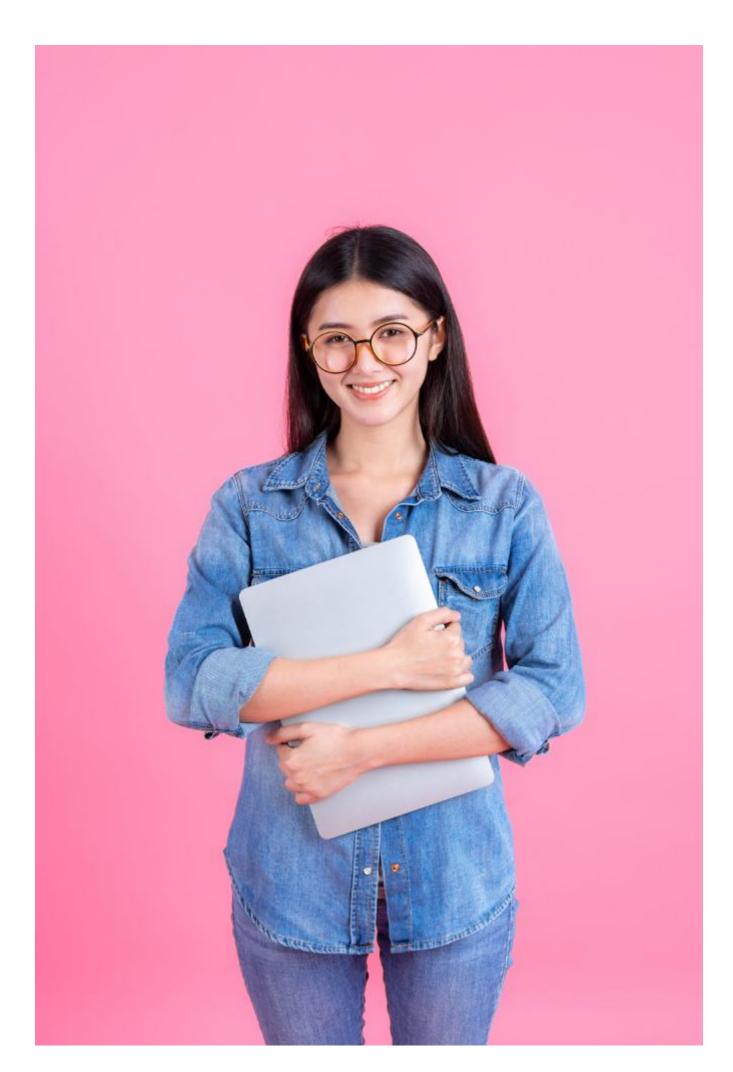
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Interview (ONLY for Medicine and Master of Public Health programme)

In addition to academic qualifications, Perdana University requires all candidates to attend a Panel Interview which is designed to provide further insight into the candidates before making a final selection decision.

Assessors will be looking for evidence that you meet various qualitative admission criteria. These include your interests and enthusiasm in the profession you have chosen, your motivation, communication skills, and other attributes related to the profession.

You are required to adhere to the university's instructions when attending the panel interview, which include dressing formally, attending briefings, completing the test within the designated timeframe, and so on.



Pre -Arrival

Step 1-

a) Student Pass Application

International students registered with overseas education institutions must obtain a student pass, similar to the standard Student Pass, to participate in the program.

b) Visa Duration

The visa duration will match the length of the mobility program as stated in the acceptance letter or program documentation.

c) Visa Cancellation

- One month before the visa expiry, students must hand over their passports and flight tickets to initiate visa cancellation.
- The visa cancellation process costs RM54.00.

STep 2- . Document Submission

All required documents must be submitted to the registrar's team for processing.

Step 3 – Verification by Malaysian Immigration

- o The registrar's team will forward the documents to Malaysian Immigration for verification and approval.
- o If there are any issues with the submitted documents, additional documents will be requested until Immigration approves the application.

Processing Time: The Student Pass processing time is approximately **6 to 8** weeks. Students can check their application status via the <u>EMGS</u> website or email visapass@perdanauniversity.edu.my

Step 4 – E-VAL Approval

An e-VAL (Electronic Visa Approval Letter) is issued once Immigration approves the application. This document is mandatory for entering Malaysia.

Step 5 – E-VISA/SEV Application

- o After receiving the e-VAL, students must apply for an **e-VISA** or Single Entry Visa (SEV) before traveling to Malaysia.
- o For e-VISA application, please use this link (choose the "Students" category): eVISA Application.
- o If an e-VISA is not applicable for your country, kindly visit the nearest Malaysian Embassy/High Commission/Consulate to obtain a Single Entry Visa (SEV).
- o A list of countries required to apply for an e-VISA is available here: <u>SEV</u> Required Countries.

Step 6 - Pre-Departure Checklist

Before departure, ensure you have the following documents readily accessible:

- o **Original Passport** (as per e-VAL; notify us if it has changed).
- o **SEV or e-VISA** (forward a copy to us).
- o e-VAL.
- o **Yellow Fever Vaccine Certificate** (for travelers from Sub-Saharan African countries only).

Arrival

Step 1- Arrival at the Airport

- o Upon arrival in Malaysia, complete the <u>online arrival form</u>. Ensure all information is accurate and legible.
- o Wait for the Perdana University representative at the designated areas:

- KLIA Terminal 1: Immigration arrival counter 59-60.
- **KLIA Terminal 2**: Waiting area at the Immigration Operational Office (before the arrival gate).

Do not attempt immigration clearance independently, as this may jeopardize your student pass approval.

Step 2 – Post-Immigration Steps

Collect your luggage from the designated baggage claim area.

Step 3 – Transportation

Inform us in advance if you have arranged your own transportation. Otherwise, Perdana University will provide transportation to your accommodation.

Step 4 – Post-Medical Checkup

After arrival, you are required to complete a post-medical checkup at the nearest **EMGS panel clinic**. You can find a list of registered **Malaysian clinics** here: <u>EMGS Registered Clinics</u>.

Step 5 – Passport Submission

Once your post-medical checkup is approved, you need to hand over your passport to the **International Student Department (ISD)** for a processing period of **14** to **21 days**.
