- Princeton evaluates **all applicants the same way**, regardless of nationality. <u>Princeton Admission</u>

### ☐ 2026 Deadlines

- Regular Decision: January 1, 2026 (typical deadline). Shiksha
- Early Action / Early Decision deadlines usually occur in early November but are often closed earlier in the cycle. <a href="Shiksha">Shiksha</a>

#### ☐ Academic Records

• Your **transcript/academic record** should reflect your curriculum and results. Princeton evaluates grades in the context of your education system. <u>Princeton Admission</u>

#### **☐** English Language

If English isn't your native language and your school wasn't English-medium, you must submit one of:

- TOEFL
- IELTS Academic
- Duolingo English Test (DET)
- PTE Academic Princeton Admission

#### **☐** Writing Component

• Princeton asks for a **graded written paper** in English if applicable; this shows academic writing ability. <u>Princeton Admission</u>

#### ☐ Standardized Testing

• Princeton has been **test-optional through 2026**, meaning submitting SAT/ACT is *not required* but may be considered if you choose to submit them. <u>Princeton Admission</u>

**Note:** Recently Princeton announced it **will require SAT/ACT scores again starting with the 2027 cycle** — *this does not affect 2026 admissions but is important for future planning.* The Times of India

☐ Application Process
<ul> <li>Graduate applications go through Princeton's Graduate School portal regardless of citizenship. Graduate School</li> <li>Each department sets its own requirements and deadlines (e.g., Computer Science deadline for Fall 2026 was Dec 15, 2025). CS Princeton</li> </ul>
□ English Proficiency
• If your previous instruction was not in English, graduate programs often require TOEFL or IELTS — check your specific department's policy. <a href="Graduate School">Graduate School</a>

<ul> <li>Master's and Ph.D. applicants must hold relevant degrees and prepare academic materials like transcripts, letters of recommendation, and statements of purpose. <u>Graduate School</u></li> </ul>

☐ Undergraduate Financial Aid
<ul> <li>Princeton meets 100% of demonstrated financial need for all students — including international students — on a need-blind basis, meaning your ability to pay does not affect admission decisions. ☐ Graduate Funding
