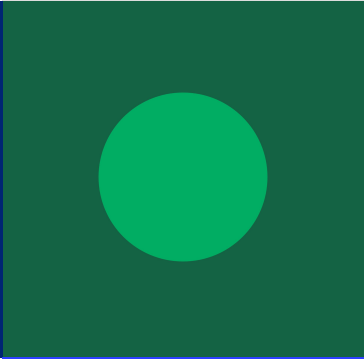
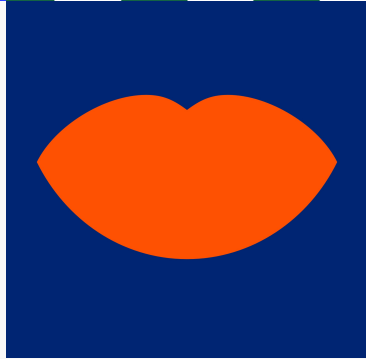

- Vilnius is the only capital in the world that you can fly a hot air balloon over.

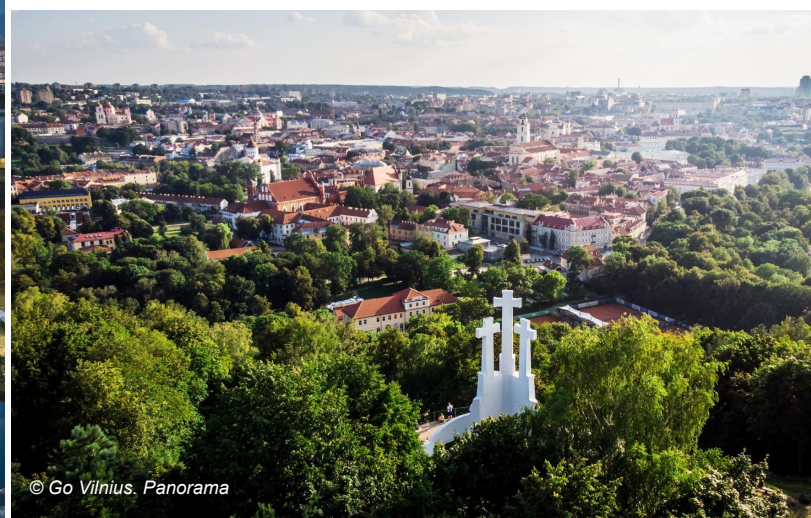

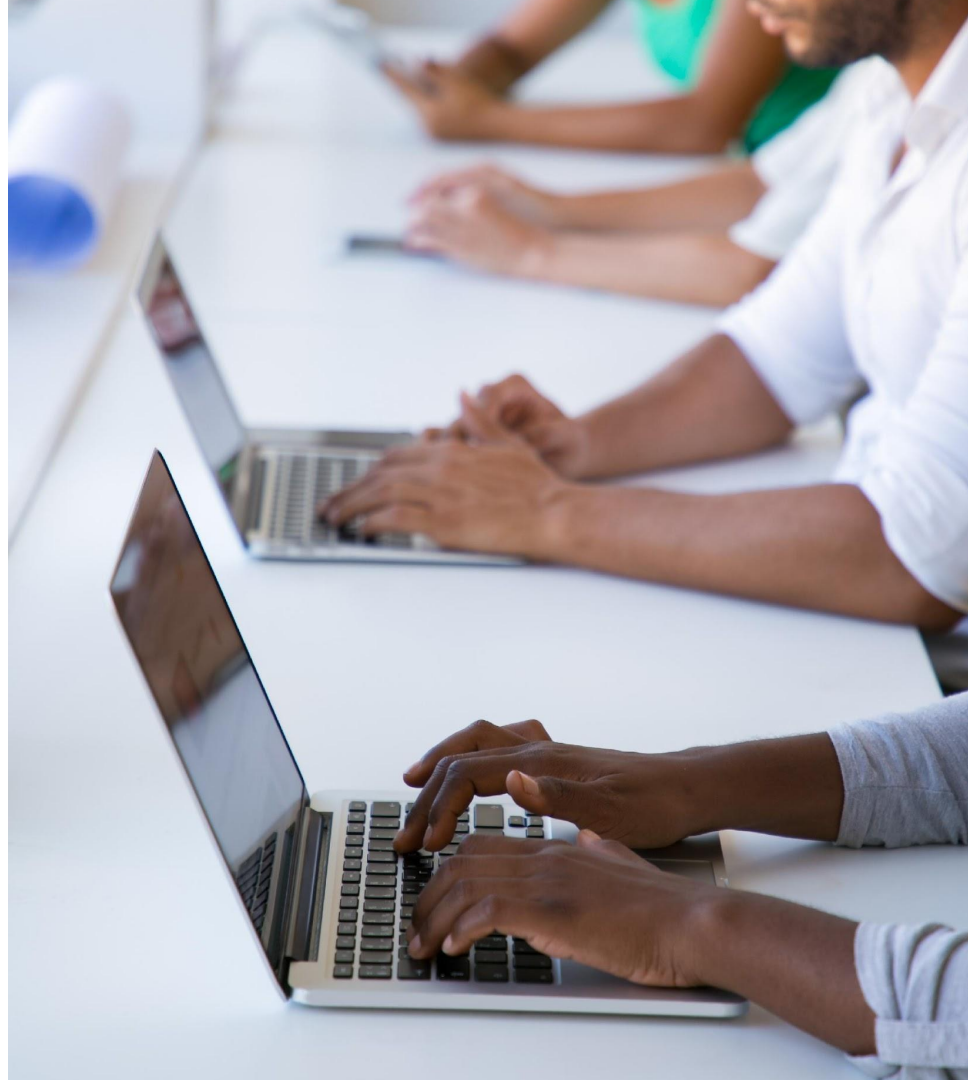
English Foundation Programme

For students needing to advance their English language skills, SMK offers English Foundation Programme. The duration of the programme is one or two semesters and guarantees to bring your language level to the upper intermediate level which is required to study at SMK.

The programme consists of 12 academic hours per week plus various independent and group projects in order to help students better prepare for studying at the university.

Application deadline

July 15th - For Applicants from non-EU/EFTA Countries

August 1st - For Applicants from EU Countries and for non-EU/EFTA Countries with Lithuanian Embassies

Prepare the following:

- High School Transcript and Diploma (Translated into Russian or English);
- Proof of sufficient English language. Valid FCE, IELTS 5+, TOEFL 59+ or Language Cert IESOL B1+ test results. If not available, then SMK test could be arranged (except for English Foundation programme);
- Motivational Essay;
- Proof of paid application fee of 120 EUR (non-refundable).

- Average school graduation grade - 8,0;
- Qualification recognition from SKVC;
- Be a citizen of one of Eastern Partnership countries.



40% TALENT SCHOLARSHIP

Scholarship applies for first year of studies, after that students can apply for other scholarship programme.

Criteria for getting the scholarship:

- Average school graduation grade - 8,5;
- Qualification recognition from SKVC;
- Motivational letter (Why am I eligible for Talent Scholarship?);
- English language level B2 (with proof of IELTS, TOEFL certificates or by passing a language test at SMK).

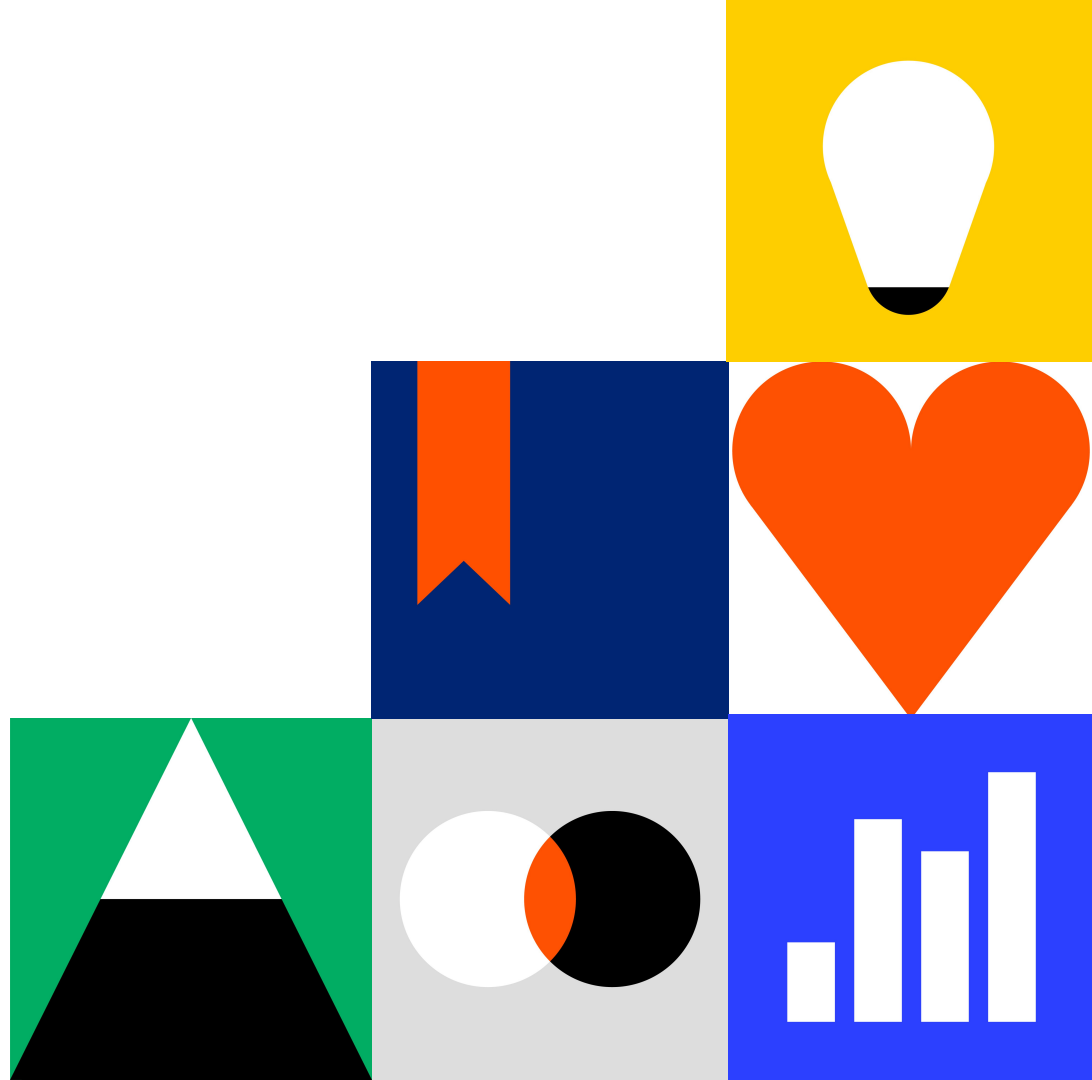
Tuition Waiver Requirements:

- A tuition waiver is granted solely to students of Ukrainian higher education institutions, **fleeing from the war in Ukraine** and wishing **to continue** their studies in Lithuania;
- The student has to be able to study in the English language;
- The applicant has to fill out an **Application Form**;
- The applicant has to participate in an interview with the Admission Committee

Application Process

- Register on apply.smk.lt
- Fill up the application by selecting your preferred study programme
- Pay the non-refundable application fee
- Submit secondary school documents with SKVC for evaluation
- Send us your SKVC application number for proof of purpose
- Once the SKVC is out - notify SMK to arrange a motivational interview
- The decision of admission committed will be announced in 5 working days
