

## 1. About the University

**Technical University of Gabrovo (TUG)** is a Bulgarian public university offering engineering, technology, economics and management degree programmes. The university attracts international students from countries such as Greece, Iraq, Moldova, Poland, Russia, Syria, Tunisia, and Ukraine. [bta.bg+1](http://bta.bg+1)

## 2. Admission Requirements for International Students

### Eligibility

To apply, international applicants must hold diplomas for completed secondary education that allow access to higher education in the country where the qualification was obtained. [ТУ-ГАБРОВО+1](#)

### Required Documents

Typical documents include: [ТУ-ГАБРОВО](#)

1. **Completed application form** with biographical data and chosen programme.
2. **Copy of secondary education diploma & transcript** (grades/supplement).
3. **Certificate of eligibility** for higher education continuation from your home country.
4. **Academic transcripts** (if applying for a part of a programme or exchange).

□ **Deadline:** International applicants should submit documents **at least two months before the academic year start** because of visa preparation timelines. [ТУ-ГАБРОВО](#)

### Notes:

- For **Master's applicants** (who already hold a Bachelor's), apply by the start of the semester. [ТУ-ГАБРОВО](#)

## 3. Application Process

### How to Submit Documents

International applications can be submitted: [ТУ-ГАБРОВО](#)

- **In-person** at the International Office (Room 3209, Rectorate).
- **By post/courier** to:

## □ Admission Certificates & Visas

Once admitted, TUG sends your documents to the Bulgarian Ministry of Education and Science, which issues a **Certificate of Admission** required for a **long-term (D-type) student visa**. [TY-ΓΑΒΡΟΒΟ](#)

## □ 4. Language & Preparatory Training

If you need Bulgarian language preparation before starting a degree programme:

- TUG offers a **preparatory Bulgarian language course** (minimum 9 months).
  - It includes **Bulgarian language training plus subject prep** (math/physics or economics).
  - A final exam grants a certificate of completion.
  - If you already speak Bulgarian, you may be directly enrolled after a language proficiency exam. [TY-ΓΑΒΡΟΒΟ](#)

## □ 5. Mobility & Exchange Opportunities

### □ Erasmus+ Exchange

TUG participates in the **Erasmus+ programme**, allowing study/training mobility if your home university has an **Inter-institutional Agreement (IIA)** with TUG. [TY-ΓΑΒΡΟΒΟ](#)

- **Winter Semester:** 15 May

## 7. Visa & Entry to Bulgaria (Important)

International students usually require a **D-type long-term visa** for studies in Bulgaria. This process begins after **admission and issuance of the certificate** by the Ministry of Education and Science. [ТУ-ГАБРОВО](#)
