The **University of Hull** is a public university in Hull, England, offering undergraduate, postgraduate taught, and research degrees. It welcomes international students from many countries and provides dedicated support throughout the application and study process.

□ 2. Admissions — How to Apply

□ □ Undergraduate

You can apply **either directly to the University of Hull** or through the **UCAS application system** (if you want to apply to multiple UK universities). [University of Hull](#)

Steps to apply:

1. **Check entry requirements** for your country and chosen course. Some courses have specific requirements. [University of Hull](#)
2. **Submit your application** via UCAS or directly through an approved international agent. [University of Hull](#)
3. **Meet all conditions** (academic offers, English language, etc.). [University of Hull](#)
4. **Pay your tuition fee deposit** (required before a CAS is issued; usually exempt for some scholarships/sponsors). [University of Hull+1](#)
5. Receive your **Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS)** to apply for your visa. [University of Hull](#)

□ Postgraduate

Similar process — check specific entry requirements for Master's or research degrees on the Hull website country pages. Agents can also help with course guidance. [University of Hull](#)

□ 3. English Language Requirements

- If **English is not your first language**, you must show evidence of English proficiency. [University of Hull](#)
 - Undergraduate courses generally require: **IELTS (Academic) overall 6.0 with at least 5.5 in each skill** (some programs require higher). [University of Hull](#)
 - Postgraduate requirements can vary — check your specific course page. [University of Hull](#)
 - If you don't meet requirements, Hull offers **pre-sessional English courses** before your degree starts. [University of Hull](#)

□ 4. UK Student Visa & Immigration

□ Visa Required

International students (except UK/Irish nationals) **must get a UK Student visa** to study at Hull. [University of Hull](#)

□ Essentials for Your Visa Application

You'll typically need:

- A valid **passport**
- **CAS number** issued by Hull after you accept your offer and pay the deposit
- **Proof of finances** showing you can pay tuition + living costs
- **English language evidence**, unless exempt
- **TB test results** (for students from some countries, e.g., Bangladesh) if applying from abroad [University of Hull](#)

□ Visa Costs (Guideline)

- UK Student visa fees usually are around **£490** (may vary). [Study in UK](#)
- **Immigration Health Surcharge (IHS)**: ~£776 per year of your visa. [Study in UK](#)
(These are paid as part of the visa application.) [Study in UK](#)

□ Graduate Route (Post-Study Work)

After completing your degree, you may be eligible to stay and work in the UK under the **Graduate Route visa (up to 2–3 years)** if you meet conditions. [University of Hull](#)

□ Tuition Fees

- International fees vary by course — check the exact figures on your specific program page. [University of Hull](#)

□ Scholarships & Bursaries

Hull offers **scholarships and awards** for eligible international students based on academic achievement or financial need. These do not usually need to be repaid. [University of Hull](#)

Accommodation

- The University provides **on-campus accommodation** and support finding housing. Local private lets and shared houses are also options. (Student union can advise.) [Reddit](#)

Orientation & Support

- International students get support with settling in, orientation events, and academic advice. Agents approved by Hull can also assist with pre-arrival questions. [University of Hull](#)

Working While Studying

As a UK Student visa holder, you can normally work up to **20 hours per week during term time** and full-time in holidays (subject to visa conditions).
